# **Contest Conditions**



- This contest will be conducted in accordance with <u>PBA Contest Regulation 2022</u>
- All competitors entering Novice and Graded events must have a current PBA registration to compete. Non-registered players will receive comments only.
- Beginner, Juvenile and Veteran events do not need a PBA registration.
- Competitors must compete in their own grade.
  - Playing up one grade is permitted, except for Beginner grades.
  - o Adjudicators reserve the right to provide comments only if playing up a grade.
- The Beginner Practice Chanter & Beginner Practice Pad events are interactive events for the adjudicator and the beginner to engage and discuss on their progress (theory, technique, practice regimes & practical exercises etc.).
- This contest will be conducted as an aggregate contest (D.1.07.01).
- All ties will be resolved on the March Preference. The 1st element of each Grade.
- Entries will only be accepted with payment or proof of payment (as below).
- Entries that opt to pay 'Cash on the Day' are liable for the full amount at time of registration. Late withdrawals and 'no-shows' will be invoiced for the entry fees owed.
- Where a grade comprises of more than one element, the competitor is liable for the full fee of \$12 per grade regardless of the number of elements entered.
- Perth Bagpiper (the Promoter) reserves the right to cancel any event without notice.
- Entries close Saturday 18 June 2023.
- Entries received after this time will be deemed as late, and if accepted will be subject to a late entry fee of \$10.00 per grade.
